Private Reports Release Memo

New Statute:

- All IMS Private reports and the remaining 396 reports (Mediation and Hearings) have now been updated to support GINA. On reports with detail lines, the standard statute display has been changed to include "G" at the end of the familiar "T", "A", "E", and "D" statutes. The summary pages of all standard Private IMS reports have been updated to include a calculation for total GINA only charges (GINA in combination with other statutes will appear in the "Other" column.

Other changes:

Private Inquiry Receipts Report

- The communication method is now displayed on the detail line. Room was made on the detail line by shortening the respondent name and displaying staff initials instead of staff name.
- The number of inquiries are now tallied by communication method on summary pages.
- The communication method has been added as a parameter.
- The communication method has been added as a detail line sort option.

Private Resolutions Report

- The 180 Day column is marked with an "X" if the charge age is less than or equal to 180 days.

- The summary pages include two new fields. "Charges with workplace benefits" shows the number of charges resolved during the period which have workplace benefits. "Persons receiving workplace benefits" shows the number of persons receiving these benefits.
- The full staff name is now displayed on page breaks.

Private Blank Days Report

- Cause found is now limited to EEOC cause finding for EEOC charges and FEPA cause finding for FEPA charges.
- The full staff name is now displayed on page breaks.
- Exclusions have been updated based on rules from OFP. Under these rules, a charge may be counted as excludable where:
 - There is 90 days or less from cause finding to closure.
 - The charge was transferred to the district in the second half of the fiscal year.
 - The charge was formalized during the current fiscal year and is designated as category AY
 - The charge is on hold by HQ (action D1).

Private Cause Finding Report

- Cause found is now limited to EEOC cause finding for EEOC charges and FEPA cause finding for FEPA charges.
- The full staff name is now displayed on page breaks.

Private Inquiry By Respondent Report

- A new Special charges parameter allows the user to limit charges based on Commissioner's Only, Class Only, or Directed Only.
- The user may now print a full page SBI Combo, a full page Resolution Distribution, both full page summaries, a single line summary, or no summary at all.
- A fiscal year page break has been added: if the receipt date parameters are entered or no date parameters are used, the report will break on the formalized fiscal year; otherwise, if the closure date parameters are used, the report will break on the closure fiscal year.
- A respondent county/state page break has been added.
- The last detail page of each page break group will now display the total selected for that group. The last detail page of the report will display the total for the final page break as well as the Grand Total. This means that if users print detail only (and no summary), they will still see a count of all charges within selected page breaks and as a grand total.

Hearings 396

- The Hearings Held row on the Hearings 396 has been updated to include the following cases: cases which include a hearings held action (L3) during the period, or cases which were closed with No Cause (M3) or Finding Of Discrimination (M6) during the period, and which include a decision type of Written (N5) or Bench (N6).
