**IMS APPLICATION**

- This release certifies the use of IMS on Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome browsers. IE 9 has not yet been certified for IMS.
- The benefits of using IMS on Firefox is improved performance, new screens will now open in tabs instead of new windows, and a spell check feature on some upcoming releases.
- EEOC users will soon have an icon on their desktops to launch IMS with Firefox.
- FEPA users will need to deactivate their pop-up blocker before using Firefox or Chrome, and should contact their IT person for assistance.
- Local Enforcement and National Enforcement have been removed from the Information tab in Private. In an upcoming release, we will add the Strategic Enforcement Plan (SEP) and District Complement Plan (DCP) to the Information tab.
- All of the forms within the IMS Private application were resized so that they now run in one window. SCR 5535.

**FIND CHARGE**

- Module was modified so that when last names are entered as search criteria, regardless of whether they are entered as upper or lower case, the same result will be returned. SCR 5519.

**INFO TAB**

- The 'Staff Function' field was increased to 200 characters to allow for longer office names. Previously when the staff's function was "G" (Office Of General Counsel (GC)/Office Of Legal Counsel (OLC)), an error would occur on the Information Tab. SCR 5522.

**REPORTS FACILITY**

- All report facilities were integrated into the main IMS application so that when the 'Report' button is clicked in the main application it is opened in the same window as opposed to opening a separate window for the reports facility. SCR 5529.
